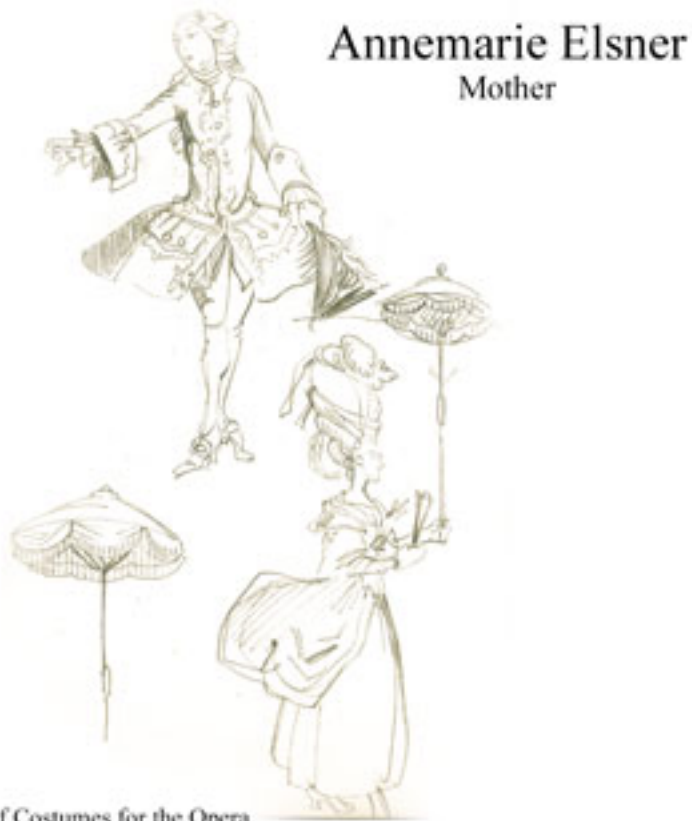


Generations - The Historical Heritage of Bettina Elsner

a 5th generation Artist with a 200 year heritage.

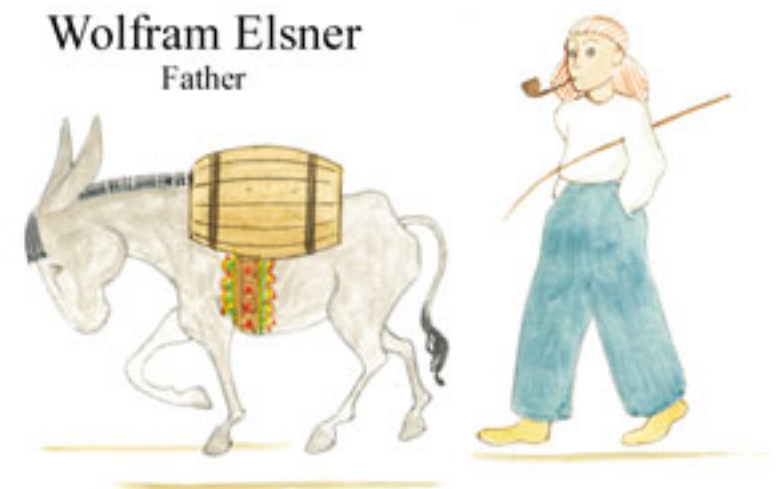
Bettina Elsner is a German Born 5th Generation Artist. Her Father Wolfram Elsner in addition to being an Orthopedic Surgeon, was a published illustrator and cartoonist for News Papers and Magazines across Germany as well as producing fantastic under glass paintings. Her Mother, Annemarie Elsner, daughter of Ernst Zimmermann, was a talented and sought after set and costume designer for the early movie industry of Europe as well as for the Stages of the Opera Houses of Europe. Bettina Elsners Grandfather, Great Grandfather and Great Great Grandfather were "The 3 Generations of Zimmermann Painters", Reinhard Sebastian Zimmermann, Ernst R Zimmermann and Ernst Zimmermann. The Zimmermann Dynasty are renowned German Painters whos art can be admired in Europes Museums of Fine Art, as well as in Books dedicated to their works.

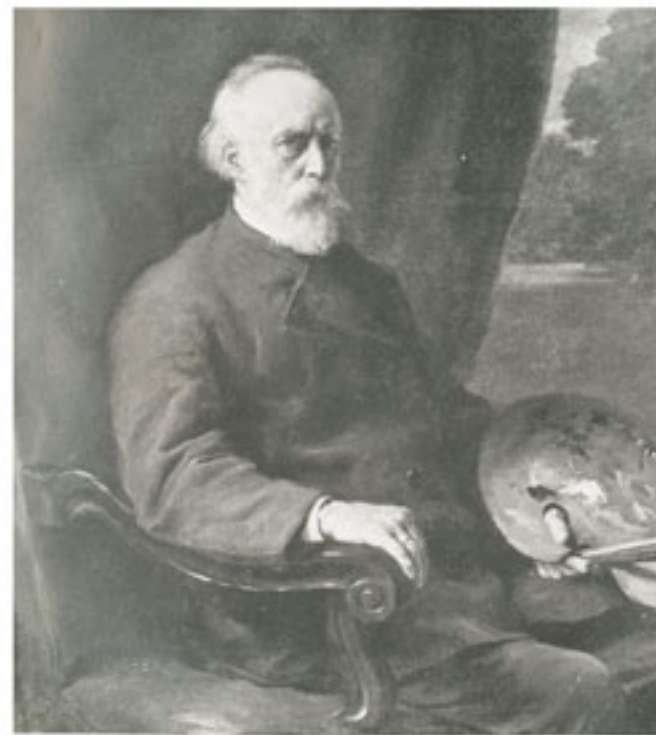
